Unfortunately, he has recently experienced a recurrence of acute lymphoblastic leukemia, a condition he first battled in 2021. After enjoying a period of remission, his cancer returned this August, and he is currently undergoing treatment at the Children's Hospital in Calgary. While his treatment is expected to last the next 2.5 years, we are hopeful that Teddy will be able to join us at school for a few days each week, health permitting.

Your support would be immensely appreciated and would help alleviate some of the burdens his family is facing.
